GATEWAY TO MCHENRY COUNTY

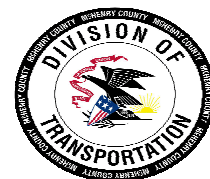
- The CAC membership consists of approximately 30 individuals that represent approximately 18 agencies and interest groups.
- The CAC has met 10 times since the initiation of the Randall Road Improvements Study.
- The purpose of the Randall Road Improvements Study CAC is to be a liaison between the public and McHenry County to help develop a Preferred Alternative that addresses the communities' needs.
